VEHICLE TECHNICIANS

As an Apprentice Technician with Adams Morey, you will learn every aspect of your chosen commercial vehicle types, which would be either trucks or vans. Your 3-year Apprenticeship Programme will equip you with both the knowledge and the practical skills needed to ensure our clients vehicles are serviced and maintained to the highest standards.

Which Technician Apprenticeship could I do?

There are many Technician Apprenticeships available through Adams Morey. For trucks, you may undertake a Level 3 Standard in Heavy Vehicle Maintenance and Repair, and for vans a Level 3 Light Commercial Vehicle Maintenance and Repair. Each of these apprenticeships are supported by our manufacturing partners and their approved training providers. You have the potential to move onto a Level 4 Management qualification.

Where Do They Take Place?

The majority of your Apprenticeship Programme will be spent in your own dealership, learning on the job, and paid a wage too. This is supplemented by college blocks, where you will spend time at the purpose built DAF Trucks Centre of Learning at the City of Bristol College, learning both theory and practical skills.

You will also be visited in-house by a dedicated Skills Coach, who will observe and assess your competence in the workplace. A dedicated Mentor will always be on hand too to support your personal and professional development whilst at work.

PARTS ADVISOR

Working in Parts puts you at the centre of everything we do. Whether you're dealing with our own Workshop Technicians or our external customers, face to face or over the phone, our Parts Apprenticeship Programme will equip you with the knowledge and skills needed to provide the very best service.



How Does it Work?

Throughout your two year Parts Apprenticeship Programme, you will be supported by your own team as well as a dedicated Development Coach who will visit you in-house and support your learning towards your Level 3 Supply Chain Practitioner qualification. You will also spend some time at a specialist college, developing theory and practical skills. In addition to this, training will also be provided by our manufacturing partner DAF at their industry leading Training Centre in Haddenham, Buckinghamshire, where you will learn everything you need to know about the market leading DAF product!

You could be carrying out a simple repair to the spraying and finishing of vehicles that have been involved in collisions and incidents. Your college blocks will be based at the IMI accredited RWC Training Centre in Milton Keynes and you will develop the skills to work independently but also operate as an effective team member with excellent customer service handling skills.

Level 3 Vehicle Damage Panel Technician - 24 Months

What does a typical day look like?

You could be carrying out simple repairs to the removal, repair and replacement of vehicle body panels. Your college blocks will be based at the IMI accredited RWC Training Centre in Milton Keynes and you will develop the skills to work independently but also operate as an effective team member with excellent customer service handling skills.

A viable alternative to full-time education

A government approved apprenticeship with Adams Morey means trainees earn while they learn and avoid all costs associated with a university education. This means the following will be paid for:
